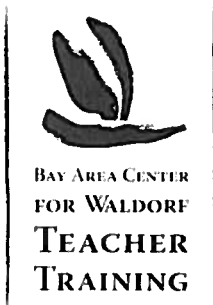

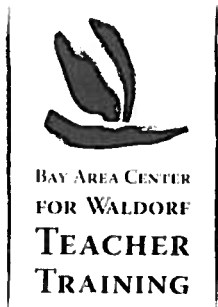

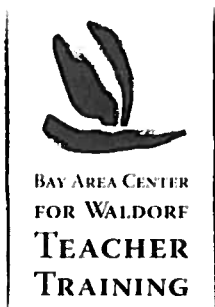

Required Books 2011-2012

Rudolf Steiner's five "basic books" constitute the broadest introduction to Anthroposophy. The only basic book required for the Bay Area Center for Waldorf Teacher Training classes is *Philosophy of Freedom*. The other basic books are also important references: *Occult Science*, *Theosophy*, *How to Know Higher Worlds* (formerly called *Knowledge of Higher Worlds and Its Attainment*) and *Christianity as a Mystical Fact*.

Other recommended books by Rudolf Steiner which you might find useful as background reading are: *From Jesus to Christ*; *From Buddha to Christ*; *Man's Being, His Destiny and World Evolution*; *Evolution of Consciousness*; *Cosmic Memory*; *Theosophy of the Rosicrucian*; *Guidance in Esoteric Training*; any of the Gospel lecture cycles; any of the Karma lecture cycles; and as a general reference: *The Human Life* by G. and G. O'Neil.

From Marin, take the Richmond-San Rafael bridge 580 east. Exit at Bayview Ave. Turn left at stop, and go over the freeway. Turn right at Carlson Blvd, and proceed east. Go under the freeway overpass, and take the on ramp to 80 east immediately on the left. Follow 80 east to San Pablo Dam Road. Bear right, and follow San Pablo Dam Road east for two miles (approx) until you reach Clark. Turn right and follow Clark to the end of the road.
