

INTERIM HIGH SCHOOL SPANISH TEACHER February 24 – June 12, 2020 Job Description

General Description

The *ideal candidate* for the Interim High School Spanish Teaching Position is an experienced high school Spanish teacher who demonstrates fluency in the Spanish language and cultural competency in the Spanish-speaking world. This is an hourly position, teaching 12 periods per week until early May when it is reduced to 9 periods per week.

Teaching Responsibilities

Teaching duties include preparations for classes, including preparation/clean-up of the classroom as necessary, constant evaluation of student progress, and classroom management. The interim substitute also is responsible for taking daily attendance and providing a narrative evaluation for each student at the end of the semester. The narrative evaluations and grades are to be submitted electronically by mid-June.
