O'Neil.

## Directions to Marin Waldorf School

755 Idylberry Road • San Rafael, CA 94903

- **From the south**, take the *Golden Gate Bridge (101 North)* through San Rafael. Take the *Smith Ranch* exit.  
**Then**, as you reach the light at the end of the ramp, turn left onto *Smith Ranch Road*.  
Smith Ranch Road becomes *Lucas Valley Road* as you cross underneath the 101 Freeway. Turn right onto *Miller Creek Road*. Turn left onto *Idylberry Rd*.
- **From the North**, take 101 South. Take the exit toward *Marinwood*. Turn slight right onto *Miller Creek Road*. Turn Right onto Idylberry Rd.
- **From the East Bay**, take the *Richmond San Rafael Bridge (580 West)* into Marin.  
After the bridge, stay on *580 West* and merge onto *101 North* (near San Rafael).  
Go just over 4 miles on *101 North* (past San Rafael) and take the *Smith Ranch* exit.  
**Then**, as you reach the light at the end of the ramp, turn left onto *Smith Ranch Road*.  
Smith Ranch Road becomes *Lucas Valley Road* as you cross underneath the 101 Freeway. Turn right onto *Miller Creek Road*. Turn left onto *Idylberry Rd*. From Idylberry continue straight up the incline. Turn left onto the campus and enter the parking lot of the Marin Waldorf School. *Welcome!*
