In 1990, Dave became the Chairman of AWSNA (the Association of Waldorf Schools of North America), and he served in that capacity for eleven years. From 2004 through 2008, he worked at the San Francisco Waldorf School, first as the Development Director, then as the Head of Administration. In addition to working on many administrative duties, Dave currently teaches the Threefold Nature of Social Life, Philosophy of Freedom, and Reincarnation and Karma. He and his wife Marianne have two grown children.
