Please visit BeeLoved Farm Waldorf Children’s Center, located in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains in Shingle Springs, CA, just 30 minutes east of the former Rudolf Steiner College in Fair Oaks, CA. References are available from other long-term Waldorf teachers who have worked for years under the traditional model but now, after having worked at BeeLoved Farm Waldorf Children’s Center, have sworn to never return to the former model. Our 4-day work week at just 26 hours per week, being mostly outdoors with the children, having decent pay, and omitting any and all additional burdens on the teachers here has made for a delightfully fulfilling life that is heavily weighted in favor of the Early Childhood Waldorf teacher.
