In addition to teaching, as a group, the Early Childhood faculty works to provide parent education, plan festivals and events including outreach, and continuously build a full and healthy program and school.

About Us: Located in the serene Pocket Area of Sacramento, California, Camellia Waldorf School is an AWSNA-accredited urban school with 155 students. Founded in 1989, we are proud to be among the most diverse Waldorf schools in North America. In 2015, we purchased our permanent location in a quiet neighborhood along the Sacramento River, close to nature and many parks. Our strong and devoted community boasts dedicated parents and friends.
