The Class Teacher delivers the Waldorf grades curriculum in a lively, age-appropriate manner. We are looking for a teacher who has strong communication skills, knowledge of child development, and is interested in using a diversity and social justice framework when developing and implementing curriculum.

The position requires a deep understanding and grounding in the foundations of Waldorf education, as well as the ability to:

- Plan daily, weekly, and block rhythms of the year. Plans are developed in accordance with the principles of Waldorf pedagogy and in light of the needs of the class.

- Deepen their understanding of Anthroposophy and child development, and seek out new materials for their teaching.

- Commit to faculty responsibilities including weekly meetings in your grades section group, weekly faculty meetings, and regular committee service.

- Build a healthy class community.

The Davis Waldorf school teaches 220 children from pre-kindergarten through eighth grade. We are in our 39th year and have been experiencing healthy enrollment, ongoing growth, and strong support from our community. We have a strong, trained and experienced faculty and a supportive parent body. We have a robust specialty program that includes Spanish, Handwork, Games, Strings, Music, Gardening and Woodworking.
