Job description

Golden Bridges After School Program Teacher for Preschool, Kindergarten, Elementary and Middle School

Golden Bridges School is a small, groundbreaking school beginning its 9th full school year. GBS was founded by Waldorf-trained teachers and currently operates in San Francisco's Portola neighborhood, serving Preschool through 7th Grade, with nearly 140 students and 35 staff members. The school is growing into a full Preschool through 8th Grade school. GBS is taking a fresh look at Waldorf education, asking what the children of today in San Francisco need from teachers and education in general. One major result of this question is the development of a robust outdoor curriculum. Each week, our Kindergarten spends two days in an indoor classroom, one day at our urban farm, and two days hiking in McLaren Park. Our grades classes are indoors for Main Lesson and some subject classes, spending additional days in large outdoor parks, at the school farm, or on field trips. 1st and 2nd grades often spend one full day a week outdoors in San Francisco's parks.

We are dedicated to becoming an anti-racist school - committed to social justice, internally and externally - that is inclusive and welcoming to all. We incorporate both anthroposophy and social justice in our weekly faculty meetings, where we delve deeper into interrupting Euro- and white-centric curriculum to bring equitable teaching practices and anti-racist policies into the classroom and school life. We ask that teachers be interested and on a path of exploring both anthroposophy and social justice.

We are looking for an after school teacher to work alongside other staff members as well as with the Director of After School Programming.

The after school program is held from 1:00pm until 5:30pm. We are offering a part-time hourly position that would run October 2021 through June 2022, working roughly 2-6:00/6:30 Monday - Friday, excluding all holidays and days school is not in session.

Responsibilities include significant logistical, administrative, and operational support functions including but not limited to:

- The daily running of the after school program. This program will follow the Waldorf pedagogy and the mission statement of the School.
- Student transportation (requires a driver's license and clean driving record)
- Drop off and pick up support
- Student check out and security
- Evening building lockup
- Covering staff breaks and program transitions
- Roll requires flexibility in addition to teaching and engages children ages 2-13
- Foster a fair and caring environment for the children, with special attention to their well being.
- Certification in basic child and adult first aid and CPR (will train).
- Minor meal preparation
- Supply inventory Report supply needs to program director

General Administrative

- Regular meetings with Program Director and other after school staff
- Report hours to Program Director
- All school holidays off

Salary and Benefits

- Hourly position for approximately 145 days between October and June.

- Possibility to support camp programming over all school breaks, including summer.
