A sense of humor, a belief in the capacities of all students, the ability to teach to a wide range of student abilities and sound classroom management skills are essential. Waldorf teaching experience preferred.

- No classes on May 11 and May 25.
- 8:15 am – 10:00 am

Compensation: \$5250 flat rate for the block.

The teacher is responsible for taking daily attendance and for providing a narrative evaluation and grade for each student at the end of the block. The compensation above includes the time needed for writing the required student assessments and reports.

This is a temporary, part-time position and carries no benefits other than those required by San Francisco.
