Sebastopol Independent Charter School is inviting applications for our handwork teacher position for teaching a Waldorf handwork curriculum in grades 1-8.

The handwork teacher teaches two periods per week per grade. It is approximately 75% of a full-time position. Our class sizes are 30-32 students. In grades 6-8, the handwork class is split in half (with the other students in wood work).

- Strong classroom management skills
- Basic knowledge and proficiency in knitting, crochet, embroidery, hand sewing and machine sewing.
- Organized! Ordering, planning and correcting are parts of the handwork teacher's job.
