- Prepare activities and snack
- Track attendance carefully. File attendance records with the office at the end of each day.
- Reset the aftercare classroom(s) after last child has left.
- Sharing updates about the program for the school newsletter

Applicants should demonstrate:

- Strong classroom management skills.
- Positive and effective communication skills with parents.
- An ability to work supportively and in collaboration with colleagues
- Commitment to Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, Belonging, and Justice
